Fix the handle (3) the insert (4), washer (5) and fix the screw (6).


Position the handle (7) on the insert (4) and screw the grub screw (8) with a 2,5 mm Allen key.



MAINTENANCE AND REPLACEMENT OF THE THERMOSTATIC CARTRIDGE AND VALVE HOLDERS


REMOVAL OF THE THERMOSTATIC CARTRIDGE

- 1) Remove the cap (1), unscrew the grub screw (2) with a 2,5 mm Allen key
- 2) Remove the handle (3). Remove the plate (4).
- 3) Close the water inlets in order to isolate the thermostatic cartridge.
- 4) Remove the stop ring (5).
- 5) Unscrew the thermostatic cartridge (6) anti-clockwise with a 30mm wrench.
- 6) Remove the thermostatic cartridge (6) and clean its filters under running water or leave to soak in vinegar in presence of limestone. **Grease the O-rings and, if damaged, replace them with new ones: 2x OR 2175 mm 44,17 x 1,78 1x OR 2187 mm 47,35 x 1,78**





THERMOSTATIC CARTRIDGE INSTALLATION

1. Check that the reference on the body of the cartridge is pointing upwards


2. Match the reference on the body of the thermostatic cartridge with the reference on the body of the mixer



3. Screw the thermostatic cartridge (6) clockwise with a 30mm wrench.


POSITION OF THE STOP RING

- 1) Place the stop ring (5) as shown in the image below.
- 2) Using the handle, rotate the broached rod (A) to reach the set temperature of 38°C (check the temperature with a thermometer).



Fix the cover plate (1) on the threaded rod (2).

Screw the adapter (4) with their O-ring (3), until the plate (1) is against the wall.


Fix the body (5), the insert (6), washer (7) and fix the screw (8).

Position the handle (9) on the insert (6) and screw the grub screw (10) with a 2,5 mm Allen key.



MAINTENANCE/REPLACEMENT OF THE SHUT OFF

- 1) Close the water inlets.
- 2) Remove the lever (1) and the grub screw (2) with 2,5 mm Allen key.
- 3) Remove the handle (3).
- 4) Unscrew the chromed adapter (4), being careful not to lose the O-ring (5).
- 5) Remove the cover plate (6).
- 6) Unscrew the flange (8) anti-clockwise, with a 17 wrench.
- 7) Remove the diverting cartridge (9).
- 8) Before replacing the cartridge, clean thoroughly and grease the inner seat of the body.
- 9) Replace the cartridge (9). Place the pivot in its seats.
- 10) Screw the flange (8) and the threaded rod (7).
- 11) Assemble the trim following the instructions shown in section "TRIM FIXING".




MAINTENANCE/REPLACEMENT OF THE SHUT OFF

- 1) Close the water inlets.
- 2) Remove the lever (1) and the grub screw (2).
- 3) Remove the grub screw (3) with 2,5 mm Allen key.
- 4) Unscrew the chromed adapter (4), being careful not to lose the O-ring (5).
- 5) Remove the cover plate (6).


Shut off

- 1) Unscrew the threaded rod (1).
- 2) Unscrew the headwork (2) anti-clockwise, with a 17 wrench.
- 3) Before replacing the headwork, clean thoroughly and grease the inner seat of the body.
- 4) Replace the headwork (2) and screw the threaded rod (1).
- 5) Assemble the trim following the instructions of TRIM FIXING.




Once the mixer is installed in the wall, cut along the finished wall and remove the plastic protection.




Place the plate support. Use the template to find the correct position.



Screw the two screws to fix the plate support. Two different type of screws are provided: two long 20 mm and two long 30 mm. Try first with screws long 20 mm; if they cannot be screwed, use those long 30 mm.




Press the plastic threaded rods and check that they are placed in the **ON** position.





Screw the retaining nut (1), on the plastic threaded rod (2) to press the template (3). Fix the grub screw (4) with the 2 mm Allen key (5).

Repeat on each ON/OFF button




Unscrew the plastic threaded rod (2) and the retainer nut (1). Remove the templates (3).
Cut the plastic threaded rod as close as possible to the retaining nut. Remove the cut part.




Screw the plastic threaded rod with the retaining nut back in place



Pour silicone between the plastic protection and the wall and over the plate support.



Recommended:
Leave a water safety exit




Push the cover plate against the wall.



Check the correct functioning of the closure system



MAINTENANCE/REPLACEMENT OF THE SHUT OFF

- 7) Close the water inlets.
- 8) Remove the screw (2) and plate support (3)
- 9) Unscrew the ON/OFF cartridge (4) anti-clockwise with a 30mm wrench.
- 10) Remove the ON/OFF cartridge (4) and clean under running water or leave to soak in vinegar in presence of limestone.
